2014 Dog Races May 3th / Railroad Park / Main & 6Th Rules and Regulations

- 1. There will be a double elimination race with 2 to 5 dogs racing at one time.
- 2. The winner will advance to another elimination race.
- 3. Dogs will race in order of their registration.
- 4. The announcer will call the numbers of the dogs that are to race in each race.
- 5. Because of the time involved, there will be only a two minute delay between races or the time it takes for the numbers to be called.
- 6. There is no pushing your dog in order for it to run and there is no reaching out for it at the finish line.
- 7. The judges will have final say whether a dog is disqualified from a race.
